

## Community Speedwatch Online

Highlights are:

- An online system where speed data is entered onto a database shared by the police and all other community speedwatch groups.
- The police send letters to those caught speeding.
- Data is available showing speeding statistics. A key measure is reduced repeat offending which is considered success of the scheme.
- The police can prosecute repeat offenders.
- Individuals need to complete online training to become registered before participating.
- We would need to purchase or borrow speed guns. A hand held speed gun costs around £200.
- At least 2 people are needed: one to use the speed gun and one to record registration numbers and speed. Somebody presumably then has to enter the data in the database.
