Electric Vehicle Charging Locations

Good Morning,

I am getting in contact regarding electric vehicle (EV) charging points. In 2019 Buckinghamshire Council installed approximately 60 electric vehicle charging points in residential areas where there is no access to off-street parking. These installations were completed using funding secured from the Office for Low Emission Vehicle's (OLEV) On-Street Residential Charge Point Scheme. We are now preparing to submit a second application to this fund with the hopes of installing a second round of electric vehicle charging points across the county.

Since the first round of installations Buckinghamshire Council have completed an Electric Vehicle Charging Plan. This plan is to help create a strategic approach to our future installations and to guide our future bidding. The plan used a range of data sources to identify priority locations, suitable charger types and the most appropriate commercial models. Having received these outcomes we now plan to target the priority areas identified through a second application to the OLEV On-Street Residential Charge Point Scheme.

Stoke Mandeville has been identified as one of the priority areas for installation by this work. We are now working to identify potential charger locations within the town, **primarily on-street locations in residential areas with limited access to off-street parking**, however some council owned car parks will also be considered by OLEV.

In our previous application Parish and Town Council's helped to identify potential locations using their local knowledge which was extremely helpful. Therefore, I am getting in contact with yourselves to ask for any suggestions or guidance on potential locations. This could include specific roads or broader neighbourhood areas that you think would be suitable.

We are working to identify potential locations over the next month, therefore any guidance you can provide by the **12**th **of June** would be greatly appreciated.
